Frank Wesley Barney

WINFIELD, Kan. — Frank Wesley Barney, age 95, formally of Tonkawa, passed away on Oct. 21, 2012, at the Good Samaritan Rest Home in Winfield, Kan.

A service will be held at 2 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 25, 2012, at First Baptist Church in Tonkawa. Burial will follow at Tonkawa IOOF Cemetery, under the direction of Anderson Funeral Home. The family will be present at the funeral home to greet friends on Wednesday evening from 5-7 p.m.

Frank W. Barney was born on March 7, 1917, in Carnegie. He grew up and farmed around Fort Cobb. He married Wilda Morgan on Nov. 19, 1940, and they had one son, Dwight Barney in 1942. He moved to Tonkawa in 1948 and went to work for the Tonkawa water department. He worked as a water superintendent until he had a heart attack. After his heart attack he had a plumbing shop and worked for Smith Gruner machine shop until he retired.

Wilda Barney passed away in 1992 and he married Betty Mason in July of 1998 in Tonkawa. Betty passed away on March 27, 2007. He moved to Winfield, Kan. to live with his son Dwight Barney and his wife Rosalyn. He moved to the Good Samaritan in August of 2012.

He was a member and deacon for First Baptist Church of Tonkawa. He loved greeting people and handing out the Sunday bulletin. He was also a member of the Tonkawa Fire Department. He loved to fish, watch ball games, work in the garden, and pick and shell pecans.

He was preceded in death by his parents; four brothers, Andrew Barney, Elvis Barney, Carl Barney and Paul Barney; one sister, EllaMae Chapman; his first wife, Wilda; his second wife, Betty; step-daughter Marilyn Hook and one grandson, Max Thorson.


He is survived by a sister, Viola Beall of Santa Rosa, Calif.; a son, Dwight Barney and his wife Rosalyn of Winfield, Kan.; two step-sons, Wes Mason and his wife, Teresa of Ponca City and Jack Mason and his wife, Christie of Frisco, Texas; two step-daughters, Paula Carr and her husband, Fred of Tonkawa and Julie Pickle and her husband, Terry of Glendale, Ariz.; eight grandchildren and 23 great-grandchildren.
