That Matthew Bagg & Ormond Morgan otherwise
called Ormond Morgan both of the county aforesaid on the twenty
third day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred & ninety one in the county aforesaid made their
certain covenant in writing with the said Diana sealed with
their seals & dated the same day & year aforesaid which said
covenant the said Diana on her part hath well & truly approved
& kept by which said covenant the said Matthew & Ormond
on their part covenanted promised & agreed that they the said
Matthew & Ormond would pay to the said Diana three
thousand weight of inspected tobacco at Augusta on or before
the first day of December thence next ensuing in consideration
of the value thereof having been received by the said Matthew &
Ormond of the said Diana - Nevertheless the said Matthew
& Ormond disregarding their covenant made in manner & form
as aforesaid hath not yet paid the said tobacco therein mentioned

and so they have not kept their covenant aforesaid in manner &
form aforesaid made with the said Diana altho so to do they have
been often requested by the said Diana but they have wholly &
completely broken the same wherefore the said Diana saith
she is prejudiced & hath sustained damage to the value of
thirty pounds & therefore she produces the writ and so forth
And the said Diana brings in to court the writing aforesaid which
testifies the covenant aforesaid

Wherefore your petitioner prays Prout may Your requiring the
said Matthew Bagg and Ormond Morgan, personally or by their attorney to
be and appear before the Honorable the Judges of the Superior Court (or one of
them) to be held in and for the county of Wilkes on fourth Tuesday in February
next then and there to answer your petitioner in an action of covenant
and so forth
